

THE DRESS CODE

BOYS

- Dark coloured tailored trousers
- Black or brown leather shoes
- Shirt with a stiff collar (any single colour or striped or checked)
- A tie (own choice) is optional
- A smart, sweater / jumper; cardigan; a jacket is permissible if tailored
- Discreet logos on shirts and tops should be no more than 3 centimetres long
- Suit (optional)

GIRLS

- Dark coloured tailored **knee-length** skirt / or **knee-length**, tailored shorts
- Dark coloured tailored full-length trousers
- Black or brown leather shoes
- Shirt / blouse (any single colour or striped or checked) with a stiff collar
- A smart, sweater / jumper; cardigan; a jacket is permissible if tailored
- Discreet logos on shirts and tops must be no more than 3 centimetres long
- Suit (optional)

PE Students

Students taking AS/A2 PE should dress according to the dress code above and change into their PE kits for practical lessons.

The PE Kit consists of Wilmslow High School logo:

- White Polo shirt
- Black shorts
- Fleece

BTEC Students

Students on the BTEC course should wear the full Sports College tracksuit/kit, though may dress in accordance with the dress code should they choose, but it must be full kit or full dress code and not a 'mixture' of both.

The BTEC Kit consists of Wilmslow High School Logo:

- Track Suit trousers
- White Polo shirts
- Black Polo shirts
- Black shorts
- White socks
- Black sweatshirts (plain black no hoods)
- Fleece
- Rain jackets

STUDENTS MUST NOT WEAR:-

- Denim
- Leather jackets
- Polo shirts
- Cropped trousers or leggings
- Hooded tops
- Tops that show a bare midriff or are low cut are inappropriate
- Trainers
- UGG boots or similar
- Caps or hats

Discreet earrings are allowed, but nose, eyebrow and other visible body piercing are not acceptable at school. Tattoos should not be visible.
